Examples From Job

- ***Who was Job before this happened?***
 - ***It didn't take this loss for Job to trust in God.***
 - ***Job was an example before these things happened.***

Job Before The Disasters

- ***Job 1:1***
- ***He was Blameless***
 - ***Perfect (not sinless perfect)***
 - ***We are to be perfect – Matthew 5:48***
- ***He was Upright***
 - ***Straight, not crooked, in his walk with God.***
- ***One who “feared God and turned away from evil.”***

Job Is Attacked

- ***Job 1:6-8***
 - *Would, could God bring my name up?*
- ***Job 1:9-12***
 - *Satan accuses God or putting up a hedge around Job*
- ***Satan attacks and spares nothing***
 - *Yet V. 22*

Job Is Attacked

- ***Job 2:1-8***

- ***After everything, God is still able to ask – “have you considered my servant Job?”***

- ***What about Chapter 2 of your book?***

- ***Could God still ask “have you considered my servant _____”?***

- ***Could all of that happen to us and we still answer like Job in 1:21-22?***

 - ***Job 2:9***
 - ***She has reached her breaking point.***
- ***Could I respond like Job?***
 - ***Job 2:10***
