- Sarah called him lord (v6)
- Sarah trusted in God (v5)
- Sarah was a hidden person (vv3-4)
- Sarah was submissive (vv1-2, 5)

CALLING HIM LORD

- Sarah obeyed Abraham (v6)

Obedience is not slavery; drudgery

– Obedience to God; obedience to Christ

John 14:15

– Obedience to government

Romans 13

– Obedience from headship

1 Corinthians 11:3

CALLING HIM LORD

- Sarah called Abraham lord (v6)
Showing him reverence and respect
 - Same use in **Ephesians 5:33**
 - See Sarah's part **Genesis 12:1-5; 18:19**
 - The word means "fear": *Reverence consists of love and esteem, which produce a care to please, and of fear, which awakens a caution lest just offence be given.*

For in this manner, in former times, the holy women who trusted in God also adorned themselves, being submissive to their own husbands

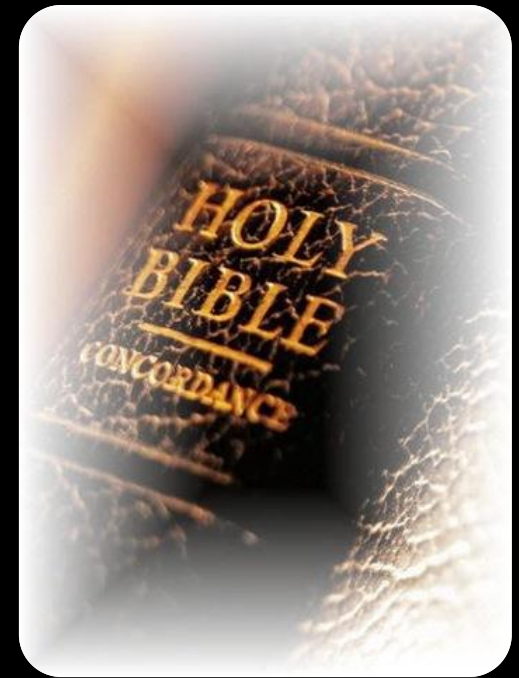
