- Fear can be taken away

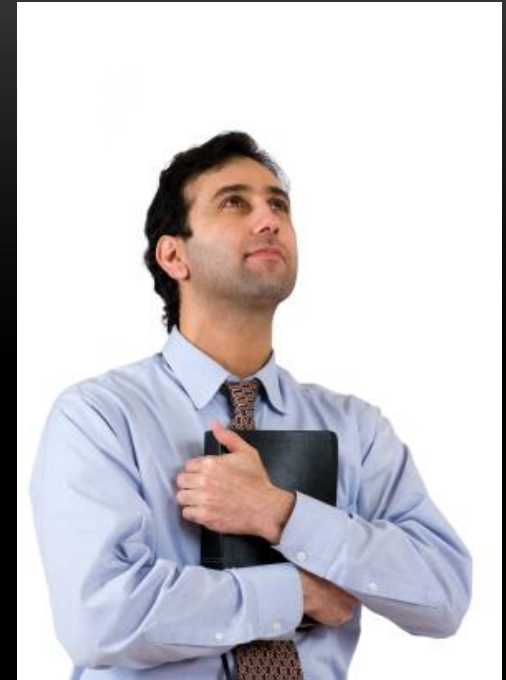
