


The Hebrews were enslaved by Egypt Moses thought he was their SAVIOR Acts 7:23-25

Moses and Aaron demand the release of the people Exodus 5:1-3


- Egyptian reaction Exodus 5:4-19

What Moses did not see - God saw Exodus 6:1




David Presuming The Will Of God
