 - Hebrews 6:18



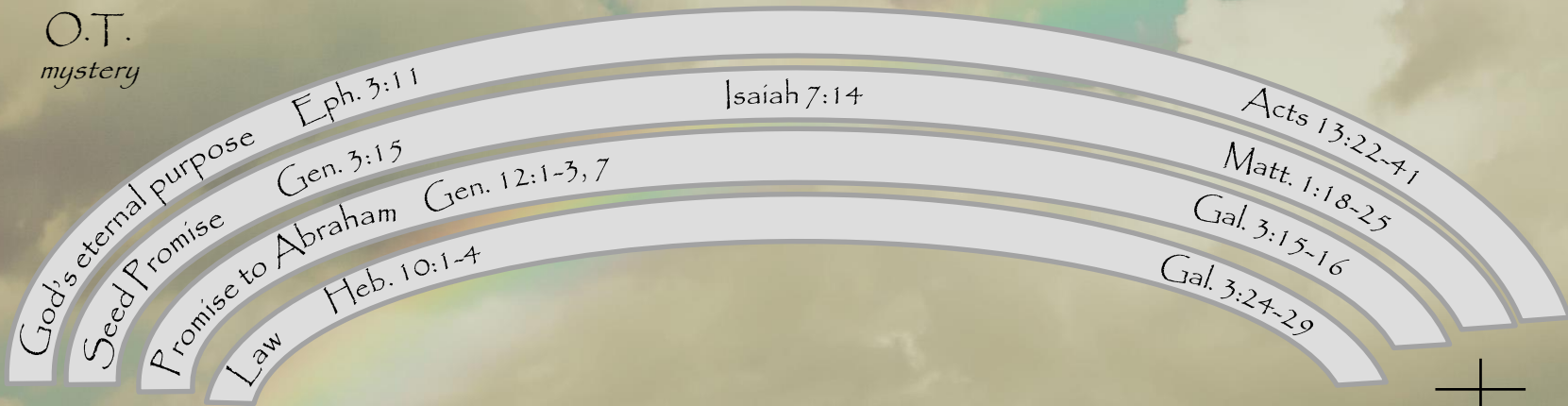
