

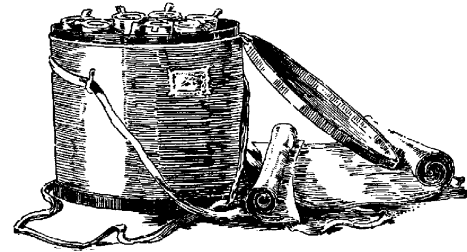

Daniel kept a custom he had from childhood


**Daniel 6:10**
