





FEAR (Luke 12:1-7)

- At first seems contradictory
- Not saying to REMOVE fear, but order it rightly
- See correctly: see eternity
- Be afraid of the right things to the right degree
- Fear of God tempered with trust



POSSESSIONS (LUKE 12:13-34)

- Luke 12:13-21 (Parable of the "rich fool")
- Focused on self
- Failed to see eternity
- Luke 12:22
- Don't worry about basics of survival?
- Usually just lack of preferred type.
- Ravens, lilies: God provides



POSSESSIONS (LUKE 12:13-34)


- Luke 12:29-32

- Don't worry about trivial things
- Luke 12:33-34
- Changes how we USE our possessions
- That's what Jesus did
- We have to see beyond this earth



WAITING (LUKE 12:35-48)

- Luke 12:35-38
- Jesus is concerned with HOW we wait
- Danger of Complacency
- Luke 12:45-47
- Do we act like He's coming back?
- Luke 12:47-48
- Use what you have for HIS glory
